Our Commitment:

We are committed to treating everyone with fairness, dignity and respect. This policy is our promise to uphold basic human rights in everything we do; whether we're working with colleagues, serving customers, or interacting with our wider community.

We believe in:

- Equality Everyone should have the same opportunities, no matter their race, gender, sexual orientation, disability, religion, age or background.
- Dignity Every person deserves to be treated with respect and kindness.
- Freedom People have the right to speak freely, practise their beliefs, and make choices about their lives.
- Safety Everyone should feel safe from violence, abuse or harassment.
- Fair Work People have the right to fair pay, safe working conditions and reasonable hours.

What this means in practice:

- We will not tolerate discrimination, harassment, or bullying of any kind.
- We will make sure our space (physical or digital) is inclusive and accessible.
- We support people's rights to speak up whether that's raising concerns, giving feedback, or expressing their beliefs respectfully.
- We take all complaints seriously and act on them fairly and promptly.
- We aim to work with partners, suppliers and volunteers who also respect human rights.
